

THE FOREWORD

In circumstances presenting some difficulties the fifteenth issue of The Rhodesian Annual has been produced. It is offered to the people of Southern and Northern Rhodesia and to their relatives and friends overseas as presenting some record—mainly photographic—of the life and progress of these two countries.
